

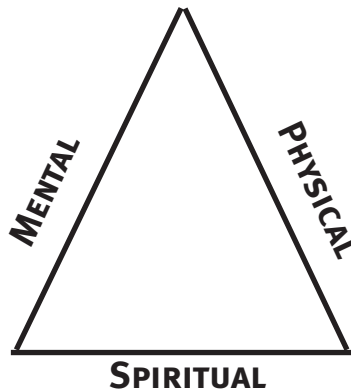
# COME BE PART OF STUDENT VENTURE!

- ◀ Be challenged to find your purpose and direction for life.

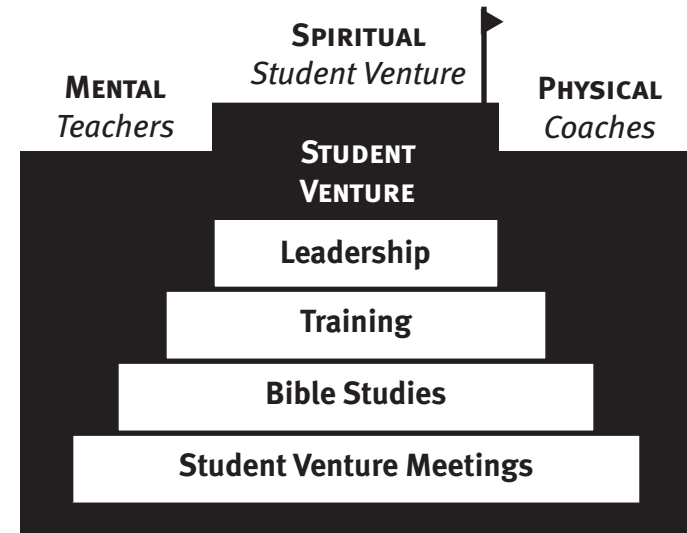


Student Venture is a national high school Christian organization and is here to help you. We are available to help you establish a balance in three major areas of life:



The school helps you develop mentally through classes, homework, and extra-curricular activities; it helps you develop physically through P.E. classes, sports, and other activities. The school is not designed to help you spiritually, so Student Venture is available as a resource to help in that area.

Student Venture is kind of like a “school within a school.” In addition to your involvement at your campus, Student Venture offers a variety of activities to help you grow spiritually and to challenge you mentally and physically as well.

- **STUDENT VENTURE MEETINGS:**  
Come visit a Student Venture meeting to find out what it’s all about. We usually have meetings on Monday nights.
- **BIBLE STUDIES:**  
We are here to help you learn about God and the Bible. You might want to be part of a small group Bible study with other students in your classes or teams, or with a group of friends.
- **TRAINING:**
